Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:



The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because water main and lead services pose a health concern to the residents of the City of Baconton and the children that commute into the city and go to the schools. The City of Baconton wants to eliminate these health concerns and provide a safe, reliable water supply to its residents and students.
