Danah Craft, Executive Director, Feeding Georgia



Danah Craft is the Executive Director of Feeding Georgia, which comprises 7 regional Feeding America food banks that collectively distribute nearly 150 meals annually through more than 2,000 partner nonprofits with emergency food assistance programs throughout the state. **Together, we lead a statewide effort to end hunger in Georgia**. Craft raises public awareness about hunger in Georgia and creates statewide programs and corporate partnerships that raise food and funds for its member food banks to support their food distribution and capacity building efforts. She is also responsible for state and federal

public policy as well as legislative initiatives that impact the food bank network. *Georgia Trend* magazine named Craft one of the 100 most influential.

Georgians in 2021 for her work to help the food bank network navigate the changes necessary to respond to the increased need for emergency food assistance caused by COVID job losses and closures. In 2023 *Georgia Trend* named her one of Georgia's most influential leaders in the nonprofit sector in its inaugural *Georgia 500* publication. An experienced nonprofit and government relations executive, Craft's prior positions include the Council on Foundations (Washington, DC), the Southeastern Council of Foundations, as well as SunTrust Bank (now TRUIST), BellSouth (now AT&T), the American Cancer Society and the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation.
