She began her professional career in 2010 as a Veterans Education Benefit Certifying Official at Armstrong Atlantic State University (Georgia Southern University) in Savannah. In this role she created Armstrong's first Military Outreach Center and led efforts to make Armstrong a Military Friendly Institution. In 2014, she transitioned to become the first Academic Advisor for Military Affiliated Students. In this role she ensured that Military Affiliated students were being advised appropriately for their degree progression and their VA Education Benefits. Upon moving back to Warner Robins in 2019, she began working at the Georgia VECTR Center as a Military Success Coach before assuming her current role.
