
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Seminole East Industrial Park Sewer Extension project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Development Authority of Seminole Co. and Donalsonville, which is located at 100 E. 3rd Street, Donalsonville, GA 39845. The funding would be used to provide sewer service to the Seminole East Industrial Park in Donalsonville, Georgia. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because adding sewer service will allow the industrial park to support job creation for residents within a 50-mile radius, including Seminole, Early, Miller, Decatur, and Baker counties.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
